Length

Hair length is extremely personal.

Longer is not always better.

Sometimes short is too short.

Style

I don't know what to say about style.

I like change ... sometimes.

Color

I have lots to say about color.

Color

It's a lot more than just depth and tone.

It's also the product to use and the technique.

Technique

Gray coverage = match the natural.

Gray blending = white is kept lighter but toned.

Color enhancement = natural + a little tone.

Color change = completely new color.

Color and highlighting.

Color and special effects.

Color Tones

Neutral Gold Ash Beige Red-Orange Red-Violet Silver/Platinum/Gray

Neutral

You can't go wrong with Neutral, but you can with all other tones.

Worldwide, 80% of natural hair color is neutral or soft ash neutral.

All other hair color falls into the 20% remaining.

Gold

Neutral + Gold = Rich Neutral

Gold + Neutral = Natural Gold

Gold + Red-Orange = Warm Gold

Red-Orange + Gold = Strawberry Blondes

Red-Orange + Gold = Warm Auburn

Red-Violet + Gold = Cool Auburn

Ash

Neutral + Green = Soft Ash

Neutral + Blue-Green = Ash

Neutral + Blue = Smokey

Neutral + Blue-Violet = Warm Ash

Beige

Gold + Blue-Violet = Beige

Gold + Green = Cool Beige

Gold + Blue-Violet + Red-Orange = Warm Beige

Red-Orange & Red-Violet

Red-Orange reacts better when mixed with Gold instead of Neutral.

You can mix it with neutral providing there is 3 times as much red as neutral.

Auburn formulas should contain 3 parts of Red and 1 part of gold

Silver/Platinum/Gray

Incredibly popular with young stylists and clients.

To increase the depth of your gray, add black

SuperGlaze

It's function is to blend or completely cover gray.

Permanent and Deposit-Only are combined in equal parts to create a SuperGlaze

The color is mixed with 20-volume developer and processed 20 to 30 minutes.

Here's why it works

When you mix a permanent color with a depositonly color (that does not contain MEA) you create a hybrid color that has a lower pH (9.25) than permanent color (10.5) and 1/2 of 1% ammonia.

Because it's mixed with 20-volume developer you get full dye development but because it has less than half the ammonia of permanent color you can only get 1 level of lightening.

Here's why it works

Because it only gives 1 level of lift, you never see brassiness.

This allows you to use a much lighter shade than you normally could on salt & pepper hair.

You can now blend the white into the dark using a blonde shade.

Permanent results with no brassiness.

Base Breaking & Blending

To transform chromastics Liquid *Shades* to a soft, 1/2 level base-breaker and blender: In an applicator bottle, Mix 2oz of chromastics shades and 2oz of 10-volume developer, Add 1/2 ounce XL-Cream, Rapidly apply to the new growth, Process 10 to 15 minutes. For a full level of lift replace XL-Cream with 1/2 ounce of XL-Super. For larger regrowth add 1/2 ounce of extra developer.
